Tell us about your family?


Wife, Sally. Four children: Mark, Mike, Beth & Ricky. Nine grandchildren.



Feb. 1 is next Larkspur Civic League Meeting

disabilities, and 685 children and adolescents.

On Oct. 15, 2011, Tidewater Regional Fire Academy #136 began training in Virginia Beach under the leadership of Battalion Chief Laurie Gurley. Laurie is one of the highestranking females in the Virginia Beach Fire Department (VBFD) and has distinguished herself as an exemplary leader in a male dominated field.

Among the 350,000 paid firefighters in the nation today, only 3.7 percent are women. More than half of the nation's paid fire departments have never had a female firefighter on staff.

At the fire academy class, Chief Gurley leads a staff of highly trained instructors committed to ensuring every recruit firefighter is trained and ready to work seamlessly in a team of professionals dedicated to ensuring the safety and welfare of Virginia Beach's citizens and visitors.

Chief Gurley has a personal passion for maintaining the VBFD's reputation as one of the best-trained and most respected fire departments in the nation. She not only holds her in-

structors and recruits to high standards but is a living model of what it means to be a professional member of the modern fire service.

With 25 years of service, Chief Gurley is the senior female employee in the VBFD. As a firefighter, she was assigned to the Technical Rescue Team and also served 17 years with Virginia Task Force 2/FEMA Urban Search and Rescue team.

She is a Board Certified Fire Investigator/Inspector and prior to becoming the Training Chief was the operational leader of the Marine Division. She now sits on the Hampton Roads Training Chief's Committee and the VA Dept of Fire Programs Fire Service Training Board.

Chief Gurley holds a Masters Degree in Public Administration from Old Dominion University and received her Chief Fire Officer designation from the Commission on Fire Accreditation International. She continues to strive for excellence and is currently completing her final research project for the Executive Fire






